### **Sketching Days**

**Thursday 2nd June – Boxgrove Priory and Ruins** This lovely old church dates from the early 12th century. And is located approx. 3 miles from Chichester. The Priory and Ruins offer many opportunities to paint and sketch in this tranquil setting. From Chichester follow the A27 towards Arundel. At the Tangmere roundabout follow the signs to Boxgrove and Halnaker. Go through the village and Boxgrove Priory is on your right. Parking is available but you'll need to bring your own refreshments.

**Friday 24 th June – Emsworth Yacht Harbour** This is an interesting location with a variety of views. The address is Thorney Road, Emsworth PO10 8BP. Take the A259 out of Chichester towards Bosham. Go through Southbourne and before you get into Emsworth you will see a sign on the right pointing out a left turn to Thorney Island (the sign is in red). Continue along this road until you see the turn to the Yacht Harbour on the right. Please be aware that you will have to pay for parking so please bring some change.

Sharon will be arriving at each location a few minutes before 9.30am and where possible would like to suggest that we gather for a coffee to get to know each other a bit before we disperse to our chosen spots. She looks forward to seeing you all.
